For appointment to this grade, an officer must have:

- Coordinate with the counties under their jurisdiction for accurate and timely reporting of disease surveillance data to National Public Health Emergency Operation Centre
- Coordinate the routine daily collection, analysis and interpretation of regional level epidemiological data in collaboration with county epidemiologists and county disease surveillance teams and draw conclusions to inform decision making.

- 3. Work closely with County Diseases Surveillance Coordinator to monitor trends of priority diseases. Provide technical assistance in undertaking initial assessments/ investigations for public health events
- 4. Provide mentorship and Technical Assistance to the County Disease Surveillance teams in the respective counties under their jurisdiction on matters of data management
- 5. Cascade trainings from national to regional level for epidemiologists, disease surveillance teams and data managers
- 6. Assist to disseminate and orientate surveillance teams on relevant national guidelines and SOPs
- 7. Timely production and dissemination of information products including SITREPs, bulletins, briefs etc.
- 8. Coordinate the development of monthly and quarterly reports within assigned regions on potential threats for purposes of mitigation.
- 9. Provide support to the Counties to improve and strengthen rapid response and contact tracing for the COVID 19 pandemic response in Kenya.
- 10. Develop an inventory of county epidemiologists and disease surveillance teams within the assigned region including documentation of capacity to elicit gaps and competency needs.
- 11. In collaboration with county leadership and county disease surveillance and response teams, provide recommendations for development of response plans for potential health crises.
- 12. Document and disseminate to both county and national level significant findings and lessons learnt.
