PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **19** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,262** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.5%. 15** of the cases are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **10** are female while **9** are female. The youngest is aged **4** years while the oldest is **78** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,985**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,840,859.

In terms of **County** distribution, **10** cases are from Nairobi, Uasin Gishu **5**, Kajiado **2**, Kiambu and Nakuru recording **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (0), 20-29 years (3), 30-39 (4), 40-49 2) 50-59 (3), 60 years and above (6).

Today, **20** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,1800** of whom **278,588** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,592** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years

(1,032), 60 years and above (3,321).

There are **25** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **107** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **6** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **5** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION:

As of August 16th 2022, a total of **20,920,745** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,631,408** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,887,620** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **329,132** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,072,585** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,581** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,051.** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.3%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
