PRESS STATEMENT

Today, 27 people have tested positive from a sample size of 1,486 tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at 1.8%. 26 of the cases are Kenyans while 1 is a foreigner. 14 are male while 13 are female. The youngest is aged 19 years while the oldest is 78 years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now 338,088 with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,848,810**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **16** cases are from Siaya, Nairobi **5**, Kisumu 2, Uasin Gishu 2, Embu and Laikipia has recorded 1 case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (8), 10-19 years (3), 20-29 years (6), 30-39 (7), 40-49 (1) 50-59 (0), 60 years and above (2).

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease, **11** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while 1 is from a facility countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to 332,268 of whom 278,673 are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,595** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years (44),

20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,321)**.

There are **27** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **96** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **8** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **6** in General Wards while **2** are in the HDU.

VACCINATION:

As of August 23rd 2022, a total of **20,990,328** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,663,880** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,895,868** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **337,803** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,092,777** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **11,723** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the

last 24 hours stand at **4,400.** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.4%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
