## UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 25, 2022

## **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **5** people have tested positive from a sample size of **865** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%. All** of the cases are Kenyans. **3** are male while **2** are female. The youngest is aged **3** years while the oldest is **43** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,093** with cumulative tests

so far conducted standing at 3,849,675.

In terms of **County** distribution, **2** cases are from Meru, Nairobi, Mombasa and Nyeri recorded 1 case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (1), 20-29 years (0), 30-39 (2), 40-49 (1) 50-59 (0), 60 years and above (0).

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease, **11** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while 1 is from a facility countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to 332,279 of whom 278,683 are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,596** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**,

20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,321)**.

There are **25** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **104** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **8** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **6** in General Wards while **2** are in the HDU.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of August 24<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **21,011,521** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,672,627** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,899,112** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **340,787** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,098,995** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **16,305** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the

last 24 hours stand at **5,342.** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.4%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
