PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **8** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,411** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%. 7** of the cases are Kenyans while **1** is a foreigners. **5** are female while **3** are male. The youngest is aged **3** years while the oldest is **59** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,463** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,889,471.

In terms of **County** distribution, **7** of the cases are from Nairobi while Busia has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (0), 20-29 years (3), 30-39 (3), 40-49 (0) 50-59 (1), 60 years and above (0).

Today, **1** patient has recovered from the disease, and is from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,712**of whom **279,086** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,626** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **70** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 4th 2022, a total of **22,175,484** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,073,065** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,694,207** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,408,212** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,146** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,188**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of 27,246,033 people.
