PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **11** people have tested positive from a sample size of **2,685** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%. All** of the cases are Kenyans. **6** are female while **5** are male. The youngest is aged **19** years while the oldest is **76** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,474** with cumulative tests

so far conducted standing at **3,892,156.**

In terms of **County** distribution, **9** of the cases are from Nairobi while Nakuru has **2** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(4)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, 2 patients have recovered from the disease, all from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to 332,714 of whom 279,088 are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while 53,626 are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **79** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
