PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **10** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,257** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.8%. 4** of the cases are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **7** are female while **3** are male. The youngest is aged **3** years while the oldest is **65** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,484** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,893,413.

In terms of **County** distribution, **9** of the cases are from Nairobi while Siaya has only **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(0)** 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today, **48** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,762** of whom **279,136** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,626** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678.**

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **41** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 5th 2022, a total of **22,184,117** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,077,161** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,695,385** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,411,571** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,505** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,470.** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.7%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of 27,246,033 people.
