PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **6** people have tested positive from a sample size of **985** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. **2** of the cases are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **4** are male while **2** are female. The youngest is aged **20** years while the oldest is **54** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,499** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,895,354**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **4** of the cases are from Mombasa while Nairobi has **2** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(1)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **4** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,810** of whom **279,184** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,626** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **6** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 8th 2022, a total of **22,204,637** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,086,493** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,697,488** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,420,656** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **2,745** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **1,077**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
