PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **12** people have tested positive from a sample size of **803** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.5%**. **11** of the cases are Kenyans while **1** is a foreigner. **7** are female while **5** are male. The youngest is aged **20** years while the oldest is **69** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,518** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,896,588**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **11** of the cases are from Nairobi while Mombasa has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(3)** 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours so the cumulative recoveries remain **332,810** of whom **279,184** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,626** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **27** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 10th 2022, a total of **22,210,667** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,089,438** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,698,062** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,423,167** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **1,433** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **504**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
