PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **10** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,217** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.8%**. **9** of the cases are Kenyans while **1** is a foreigners. **6** are female while **4** are male. The youngest is aged **5** years while the oldest is **50** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,538** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,899,298**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **8** of the cases are from Nairobi, while Kiambu and Kilifi have **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**1**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**1**), 30-39 (**3**), 40-49 (**2**) 50-59 (**2**), 60 years and above (**0**).

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours therefore, the cumulative recoveries remain **332,812** of whom **279,184** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,628** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**152**), 30-39 years (**413**), 40-49 years (**653**), 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **38** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 12th 2022, a total of **22,226,273** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,096,918** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,698,730** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,430,625** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **6,811** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,769**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
