PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **30** people have tested positive from a sample size of **3,038** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.0%**. **28** of the cases are Kenyans while **2** are foreigners. **13** are female while **17** are male. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **90** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,568**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,902,336.

In terms of **County** distribution, **15** of the cases are from Nairobi, Mombasa **4**, Siaya **4**, Busia, Embu, Kilifi, Machakos, Nyeri, Uasin Gishu and West Pokot have **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (6), 10-19 years (1), 20-29 years (2), 30-39 (3), 40-49 (4) 50-59 (7), 60 years and above (7).

Today, **6** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from various health facilities in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,818** of whom **279,190** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,628** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678.**

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years (44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **113** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 13th 2022, a total of **22,235,699** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,101,726** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,699,041** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,434,932** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **7,515** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **3,303**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **35.7%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
