#### PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **31** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,010** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.1%**. **24** of the cases are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **20** are male while **11** are female. The youngest is aged **3** months while the oldest is **85** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,678** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,908,406.

In terms of **County** distribution, **24** of the cases are from Nairobi, Siaya **4**, Mombasa **2** and Kiambu has **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (5), 10-19 years (0), 20-29 years (5), 30-39 (6), 40-49 (6) 50-59 (5), 60 years and above (4).

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours therefore; the cumulative recoveries remain **332,812** of whom **279,193** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,619** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678.** 

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years (44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59

# years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **2** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **186** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
