#### PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **18** people have tested positive from a sample size of **987** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.8%**. **3** of the cases are Kenyans while **15** are Foreigners. **10** are male while **8** are female. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **56** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,365** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,875,256.

In terms of **County** distribution, **13** of the cases are from Nairobi, Turkana **4** while Kiambu has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (2), 10-19 years (2), 20-29 years (3), 30-39 (5), 40-49 (0) 50-59 (6), 60 years and above (0).

Today, **10** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,595** of whom **278,979** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (151), 30-39 years (412), 40-49 years (652), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **83** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

#### **VACCINATION:**

As of September 19<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **21,522,783** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,848,808** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,978,512** are doses administered to those between 15 to below 18 years, **477,213** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,218,250** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is

**11,746** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **4,961**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
