## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **25** people have tested positive from a sample size of **864** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.9%**. **12** of the cases are Kenyans while **13** are foreigners. **17** are male while **8** are female. The youngest is aged **3** years while the oldest is **81** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,703**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,909,270**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **21** of the cases are from Nairobi while Kilifi has **4** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(4)** 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours therefore; the cumulative recoveries remain **332,819** of whom **279,200** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,619** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **2** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **204** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

### **VACCINATION:**

As of October 19<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **22,298,189** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,132,175** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,700,060** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,465,954** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **14,346** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **6,054**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
