PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **21** people have tested positive from a sample size of **671** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.0%**. **18** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **13** are male while **8** are female. The youngest is aged **22** years while the oldest is **53** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,749** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,910,547**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **17** of the cases are from Nairobi, Kiambu **2** while Kisumu and Nakuru has **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 years (**7**), 30-39 (**8**), 40-49 (**2**) 50-59 (**2**), 60 years and above (**0**).

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours therefore; the cumulative recoveries are **332,831** of whom **279,212** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,619** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**152**), 30-39 years (**413**), 40-49 years (**653**), 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There is **1** patient currently admitted in our health facilities, while **239** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 21st 2022, a total of **22,334,469** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,148,452** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,700,206** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,485,811** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **20,018** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **7,904**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
