PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **119** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,691** tested in the last 24 hours. **68** are male while **51** are female. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **86** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **341,235** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,937,758**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **60** of the cases are from Nairobi, Nakuru **34**, Kiambu **10**, Meru **4**, Homa Bay **3**, Kisumu **2**, Laikipia **2**, Siaya **2**, Kwale and Mombasa have only **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**4**), 10-19 years (**5**), 20-29 years (**28**), 30-39 (**33**), 40-49 (**15**) 50-59 (**9**), 60 years and above (**25**).

Today, **60** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home based Care and Isolation program. This pushes the total recoveries to **334,753** of whom **281,081** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,672** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,684**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(415)**, 40-49 years **(654)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,325)**.

There are **29** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **804** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** other patients are on supplemental oxygen, **all** of them are in the General ward.
