## UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT NOVEMBER 24, 2022

## **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **84** people have tested positive from a sample size of **730** tested in the last 24 hours. **41** are male while **43** are female. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **84** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **341,319** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,938,488**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **38** of the cases are from Nairobi, Kericho **14**, Kisumu **11**, Trans Nzoia **4**, Lamu **3**, Kiambu **3**, Embu **2**, Isiolo **2**, Kilifi **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Meru, Migori and Siaya have only **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(6)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(17)**, 30-39 **(21)**, 40-49 **(14)** 50-59 **(12)**, 60 years and above **(10)**.

Today, **37** patients have recovered from the disease, **22** from the Home based Care and Isolation program while **15** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **334,790** of whom **281,103** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,687** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the

cumulative fatalities remain at **5,684**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (415), 40-49 years (654), 50-59

years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,325).

There are 29 patients currently admitted in our health facilities,

while **851** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program.

3 other patients are on supplemental oxygen, all of them are in the

General ward.
