PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **42** people have tested positive from a sample size of **399** tested in the last 24 hours. **20** are male while **22** are female. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **78** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **341,361** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,938,887**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **19** of the cases are from Nairobi, Kilifi **14**, Kisumu **4**, Kiambu **3**, and Tana River **2**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(5)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(12)**, 40-49 **(11)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **132** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home based Care and Isolation program. This pushes the total recoveries to **334,922** of whom **281,235** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,687** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,684**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(415)**, 40-49 years **(654)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,325)**.

There are **29** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **761** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen, and is in the General ward.
