## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **62** people have tested positive from a sample size of **832** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **7.5%**. **42** of the cases are Kenyans while **20** are foreigners. **43** are male while **19** are female. The youngest is aged **11** year while the oldest is **80** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now

**338,970** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,914,841**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **59** of the cases are from Nairobi, Mombasa **2**, and Kiambu has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**11**), 30-39 (**17**), 40-49 (**13**) 50-59 (**8**), 60 years and above (**12**).

Today, **11** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home based Care and Isolation program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,921** of whom **279,302** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,619** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There is **1** patient currently admitted in our health facilities, while **370** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of October 26<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **22,457,583** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,204,824** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,700,976** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,551,783** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **31,920** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **12,793**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **36.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
