## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **35** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,841** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.9%**. **30** of the cases are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **17** are male while **18** are female. The youngest is aged **10** year while the oldest is **78** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **339,113** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,918,057**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **32** of the cases are from Nairobi, Mombasa **2** and Uasin Gishu has **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**3**), 20-29 years (**6**), 30-39 (**12**), 40-49 (**8**) 50-59 (**5**), 60 years and above (**2**).

Today, **25** patients have recovered from the disease, **24** from the Home based Care and Isolation program while **1** is from a health facility in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **333,025** of whom **279,405** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,620** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There is **2** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **408** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of October 29<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **22,531,787** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,237,748** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,701,392** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,592,647** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,606** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,560** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **36.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
