PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **34** people have tested positive from a sample size of **452** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **7.5%**. **20** of the cases are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **19** are male while **15** are female. The youngest is aged **8** year while the oldest is **82** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **339,147**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,918,509**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **32** of the cases are from Nairobi while Kilifi has **2** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**1**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 years (**6**), 30-39 (**15**), 40-49 (**5**) 50-59 (**3**), 60 years and above (**4**).

Today, **25** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home based Care and Isolation program. This pushes the total recoveries to **333,050** of whom **279,430** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,620** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **6** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **413** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program.

VACCINATION:

As of October 30th 2022, a total of **22,538,917** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,241,635** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,701,426** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,595,856** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **4,532** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **1,867** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **36.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
