PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **10** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,493** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.7%**. **7** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **6** are female while **4** are male. The youngest is aged **3** years while the oldest is **100** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,528** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,898,081**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **5** of the cases are from Nairobi, Mombasa and Turkana have **2** cases each while Kiambu has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**0**), 30-39 (**2**), 40-49 (**1**) 50-59 (**3**), 60 years and above (**1**).

Today, **2** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from various health facilities in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,812** of whom **279,184** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,628** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(152)**, 30-39 years **(413)**, 40-49 years **(653)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **28** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 11th 2022, a total of **22,217,142** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,092,598** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,698,212** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,426,332** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,664** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,642**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
