PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **13** people have tested positive from a sample size of **2,857** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. **10** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **9** are female while **4** are male. The youngest is aged **2** years while the oldest is **59** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,571**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,905,193.

In terms of **County** distribution, **11** of the cases are from Nairobi while Kakamega and Kisii have **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (1), 20-29 years (1), 30-39 (5), 40-49 (2) 50-59 (3), 60 years and above (0).

Today, **8** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home based Care and Isolation program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,826** of whom **279,198** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,628** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678.**

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (152), 30-39 years (413), 40-49 years (653), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There is **1** patient currently admitted in our health facilities, while **117** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of October 14th 2022, a total of **22,244,966** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,106,493** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,699,343** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,439,130** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **6,829** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,930**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
