PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **6** people have tested positive from a sample size of **986** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. **3** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are Foreigners. **3** are male while **3** are female. The youngest is aged **14** years while the oldest is **40** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,371** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,876,242**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **5** of the cases are from Nairobi, while Siaya has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(1)** 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **5** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,600** of whom **278,984** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **84** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
