PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **3** people have tested positive from a sample size of **626** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%. 2** of the cases are Kenyans while **1** is a foreigners. **All** the cases are male. The youngest is aged **22** years while the oldest is **51** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,382** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,877,767.

In terms of **County** distribution, **all** the 3 cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(0)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, 6 patients have recovered from the disease, all from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to 332,612 of whom 278,996 are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while 53,616 are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59

years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **83** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general

ward.
