PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **12** people have tested positive from a sample size of **707** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.2%**. **All** of the cases are Kenyans and are male. The youngest is aged **2** years while the oldest is **81** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,404** with cumulative tests so far conducted

standing at **3,880,855**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **7** cases are from Nairobi, Murang'a **2** Uasin Gishu **2** and Migori **1** case.

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours so the cumulative recoveries remain **332,629** of whom **279,013** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**412**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,032**), 60 years and above (**3,322**).

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **76** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program.

1 other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of September 19th 2022, a total of **21,828,691** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,967,289** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **2,540,152** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,321,250** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **76,227** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **18,861**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
