

Item No. 1 – Please clarify on whether the Hemoglobin Estimation Cuvettes are to be supplied with the HB meter or are for an existing HB meter product.	<b>Category C – Item No. 1 Hemoglobin Estimation Cuvettes</b> – has been deleted from the schedule of requirements. Bidders are therefore advised to ignore all the specifications related to that item as the same will <b>NOT</b> be evaluated.
2.	Request for extension of time.	The tender closing date has been extended up to <b>Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2026 at 11.00AM</b> .
