The Government of the Republic of Kenya through the Ministry of Health, State Department for Medical Services has requested for financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) to finance the **Establishment of Level VI Teaching and Referral Hospitals in Kericho and Bungoma Counties** and intends to apply part of the proceeds to make eligible payments under the contract for the provision of **Consultancy services for Comprehensive Feasibility Study for establishment Level VI Teaching and Referral Hospitals in the two (2) Counties**
2. The overall objective of the consultancy assignment is to undertake Comprehensive Feasibility Study for Establishment of the Level VI Teaching, Referral and specialized Hospitals in the two (2) counties with the scope including:
 - a) Technical and Engineering Viability
 - b) Health Needs, Demand and Functional Planning
 - c) Preliminary Schematic Design and Concept Engineering
 - d) Financial, Economic and Cost Analysis
 - e) Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA)
 - f) Institutional, Governance, Human Resource and Regulatory Assessment
 - g) Operationalization and Sustainability Planning
 - h) Risk Assessment, Phasing and Implementation Roadmap
 - i) Final Feasibility Study and Documentation
3. The detailed Terms of Reference (TOR) for the assignment can be found at the Ministry's website www.health.go.ke
4. The consultancy services will be carried out over a period of four (4) months.
5. The State Department for Medical Services now invites eligible consultant firms to indicate their

interests in providing the services. Interested firms must provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- 5.1 Core business and years in business; the firm should be registered/incorporated as a consulting firm in the core business of conducting feasibility and associated services for a period of at least seven (7) years.
- 5.2 Relevant experience – the firm shall demonstrate successful execution of at least two (2) assignments of similar nature, complexity and similar operating environment (projects financed by ADB or similar development finance institutions, in the last five (5) years. Evidence to be provided.
- 5.3 Technical and managerial capability of firm – the firm shall demonstrate as having the requisite technical capacity including relevant equipment, tools, necessary softwares etc and managerial capacity to undertake the assignment in the submitted company profiles. The qualification and experience of key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.
6. Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank’s *“Procurement Policy for Bank Group Funded Operations”-August, 2015*, which is available on the Bank’s website at <http://www.afdb.org>.
7. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or sub consultancy. In the case of a joint venture all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract if selected.
8. A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultants Guidelines.
