Global Leaders Renew Call for Safer Digital Spaces for Children and Young People

The unveiling of the Lost Screen Memorial at Place des Nations in Geneva ahead of the 79th World Health Assembly renewed global calls for stronger action to protect children and young people from online harm, cyberbullying, and unsafe digital spaces.

Principal Secretary for Public Health and Professional Standards Mary Muthoni joined The Duchess of Sussex Meghan Markle and World Health Organization Director-General Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus during the memorial event organized by Archewell Foundation in partnership with the World Health Organization and The Parents' Network.

The discussions highlighted the growing impact of harmful online environments on children and adolescents, emphasizing the urgent need for governments, technology companies, health leaders, parents, and communities to work together in creating safer and healthier digital spaces.

The event further underscored the importance of recognizing online safety, digital wellbeing, and mental health as emerging public health priorities requiring coordinated global action, stronger awareness, prevention measures, and sustained support systems for young people worldwide.
