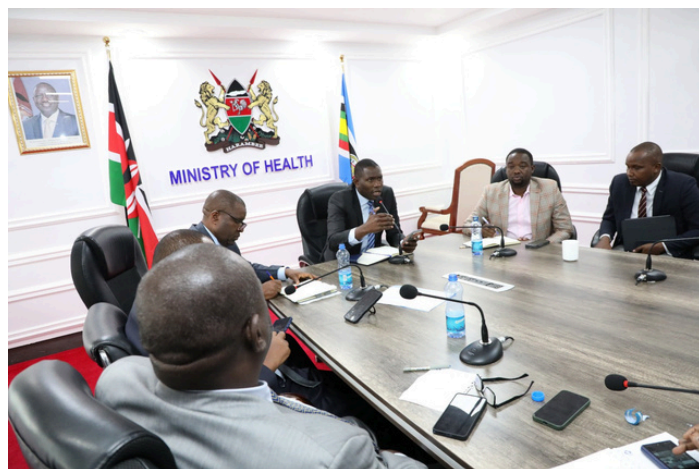
## MoH Begins Planning for National Health Summit

The Ministry of Health is set to convene the National Health Summit in early August as part of ongoing efforts to accelerate health sector reforms and strengthen service delivery across the country.

An inaugural planning meeting chaired by the Principal Secretary for Medical Services, Dr. Ouma Oluga, reviewed the Summit framework, thematic priorities, resource mobilization and logistical arrangements ahead of the national event.

The Summit will provide a platform for stakeholders to deliberate on priority areas including healthcare financing, human resources for health, digitization, commodity security, local manufacturing, innovation and strategic partnerships in support of the Government’s Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA) and the realization of Universal Health Coverage.

The Principal Secretary called for close collaboration with county governments, development partners, the private sector and other stakeholders to ensure broad participation and meaningful outcomes. The meeting was attended by Presidential Advisor on Health, Dr. Daniel Mwai, Chief Executive Officers of State Corporations and Semi-Autonomous Government Agencies (SAGAs), and senior officials from the State Department’s Technical Directorates and Administration.

## Public Health State Department Begins 2025/2026 Financial Audit

The State Department for Public Health and Professional Standards has commenced the Financial Year 2025/2026 audit following an Audit Entry Meeting chaired by Principal Secretary Mary Muthoni with officials from the Office of the Auditor-General (OAG).

The meeting reaffirmed the State Department’s commitment to transparency, accountability and prudent management of public resources. The Principal Secretary assured the audit team of full cooperation throughout the audit process and emphasized continued compliance with public finance and procurement laws.

She noted that the State Department remains focused on strengthening internal controls, promoting sound financial management and fostering a culture of integrity to achieve a zero-fault audit.

The audit will support ongoing efforts to strengthen institutional performance, enhance accountability and ensure efficient use of public resources as the State Department advances public health reforms in support of Universal Health Coverage.
