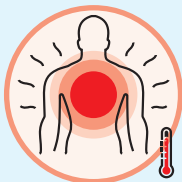

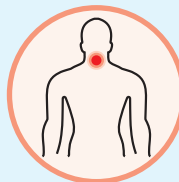
Mpox Symptoms can appear 2-21 days after infection



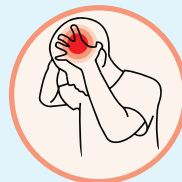

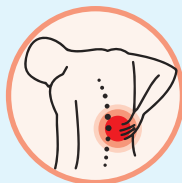

Mpox Preventive measures

Avoid close contact with infected individuals.
Abstain or maintain only one sex partner



Avoid sharing personal items like towels, utensils or clothing



Wear protective gear if caring for someone with Mpox



Wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer when soap is not available



Improve ventilation in shared spaces



Clean shared surfaces regularly

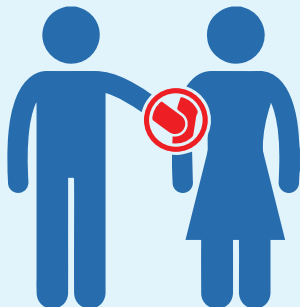

Mpox Spreads

Through person to person, through touch, kissing, sex, by talking or breathing close to someone who has Mpox.

From infected animals, when hunting, skinning, or cooking them.






From contaminated materials, such as sheets, towels, clothes or needles.

During pregnancy, when the virus may be passed on to the unborn baby.

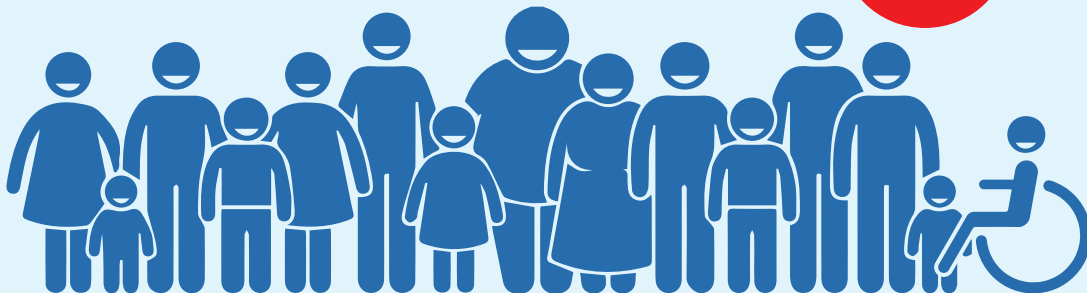

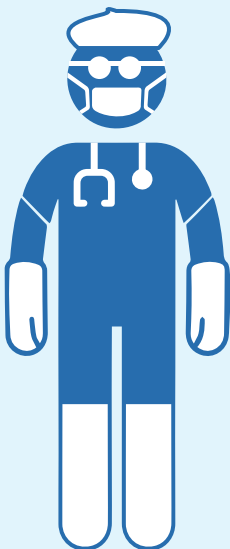
