



## **Mpox Symptoms can appear** 2-21 days after infection



Skin Rash



Fever



Sore Throat



Headache



**Body Aches** 



Back Pain



Swollen Lymph Nodes

If you experience any of these symptoms, seek urgent medical attention.












## Mpox causes a distinctive rash



If you are unsure about rash or lesions, consult a healthcare provider immediately for proper diagnosis and treatment.









## **Mpox Preventive measures**

Avoid close contact with infected individuals. Abstain or maintain only one sex partner

**Avoid sharing** personal items like towels. utensils or clothing

Wear protective gear if caring for someone with Mpox

Wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer when soap is not available









**Improve** ventilation in shared spaces





Clean shared surfaces regularly

Check health advisories for your destination

Avoid non-essential travel to areas with Mpox outbreaks

**Ensure you** have travel insurance that covers medical care

Stav informed about local destination health updates







Follow medical advice and complete the full course of treatment


Inform close contacts so they can monitor their health

## **If You Have Been in Contact** with a Sick Person

Monitor your health for 21 days

Look out for symptoms like skin rash. fever, and body aches

Avoid close contact with others during this period

Seek immediate medical advice






## Mpox can be severe

Seek medical care if symptoms appear.










## **Pregnant women with Mpox** can infect the unborn child

Be cautious with wild animals










## **Do Not Spread Rumours**

## **Mpox Spreads**

Through person to person. through touch. kissing, sex, by talking or breathing close to someone who has Mpox.

From infected animals, when hunting, skinning, or cooking them.

From contaminated materials, such as sheets, towels, clothes or needles.

**During pregnancy,** when the virus may be passed on to theunborn baby.

## **Mpox Affects Everyone**




Avoid stigma and discrimination. Support those who may be infected or at risk!











## Mpox can spread from human to human through:



**Direct Contact** close contact with lesions, body fluids, respiratory droplets


**Indirect Contact** contaminated materials such as beddings, towels, or clothing



Don't Share Personal Items. **Protect yourself and others from Mpox.** 









## If you've been in close contact with someone who has Mpox, monitor your health closely for 21 days after the last date of contact



Seek immediate medical attention if symptoms appear.




# **Use Proper PPE when Treating** a patient with Mpox



Always use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when caring for patients with suspected or confirmed Mpox.










# Teach your children **Good Hygiene**
